From the Pastor's Desk: New Life in Christ

It is always tempting in the month of January to write or preach about New Year's resolutions. No doubt, most of us want to exercise a little more and eat a little less, spend more time with our family and give ourselves to more productive endeavors.

The making of New Year's resolutions is nothing new. The practice goes back to 4,000 B.C., to the Babylonians. Even the ancients wanted to make a new start.

But in Christ, the possibilities are so much greater. Paul writes that in Christ, followers of Jesus are new creations: "Therefore, if anyone is in

Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come!" (2 Cor. 5:17 (NIV))

It is an odd thing to say of someone that he or she is "in Christ." People are not inside one another. Rather, Paul is writing about those who having offered themselves to God are united with Him through Jesus Christ in the Holy Spirit.

Those who are "in Christ" find themselves transformed, set free from the confining power of the present age. Because the Holy Spirit joins us to Jesus Christ we share in everything that is His. In Christ, we



become all that we could never be in the eyes of God if we are left to ourselves. We are not now suddenly functionally perfect saints, of course. We still limp along, straining between sin and mercy.

Being "in Christ" makes so much more possible than losing a few extra pounds. It brings assurance of God's love and forgiveness, which makes new life possible.

Confirmation Program

For any youth interested in joining Clen-Moore Church, our Confirmation program begins this month. The program is two-tiered and consists of:

- 1. Five traditional classes with Q & A about the PC (USA), learning about and discussing what we believe. This is done with Pastor Chris or Aaron on various Sunday mornings. Attendance is mandatory.
- 2. Each student is paired with an adult from the church, who mentors the student, to complete multiple action/ reflection-based activities within the life of the church. Students will be paired with adults who are active in the worship and ministry life of Clen-Moore Church and of the same gender (no family relations).

Students and mentors will receive a binder that includes a variety of activities to participate in together. They will be guided by things to think about before participating in



the church activity. Then they'll participate in the activity. Then they will discuss questions to consider in reflecting on the activity.

Included is reading through a Bible book together, attending two worship services together, attending one Session meeting, attending one committee meeting, doing a shutin or hospital visit, doing a mission or service related event, and participating in a fellowship activity together.

The student will have three months to complete these and will meet with Aaron at various points to discuss progress.

After writing a Statement of Faith that reflects on their Confirmation journey and a meeting with Session, students will be received into Membership on Pentecost Sunday, May 19th.




