Five Things to Do This Summer:

- 1. Review your medications. If you are taking an antidepressant, review options with your doctor. Many of these drugs can affect learning and memory because of an anticholinergic effect.
- 2. Drink lots of water. Remind yourself to have a glass of water occasionally since thirst declines as we age.
- 3. Use a step stool. Avoiding high reaches reduces stress on your shoulders.
- 4. Wear flip-flops at the pool. This helps prevent fungal infections.



5. Read! You can add to your vocabulary at any age.
