From the Pastor's Desk: B.L.E.S.S. Our Neighbors

Mission and ministry is all about relationships. We certainly see this in the life of Jesus. All Jesus did flowed out of his oneness with the Father (John 10:30.) In Jesus' incarnation, we see his oneness with humanity. In the Gospels, we see Jesus spending time with and building relationships with the sinners, often eating and drinking with them. It was through their relationship with Jesus that they were blessed.

Over the past many months, we have continued the Opening Doors mission emphasis. We have tried to show how Clen -Moore is reaching out to show the love of Jesus Christ, often to those who are in need. I think the more difficult question is "How do we try to relate to our neighbors, those whom we already know or 'sort of' know?"

Dave Ferguson is a pastor who is wrestling

with this question. He says, "From the very beginning, God's way of reaching and restoring the world has always been through what I would call a blessing strategy...how do we in a very practical way that's theologically grounded explain to churches how they could bless people in places they are living?"

The church came up with this:

B: Begin with prayer. We want you to ask, 'God, how do you want me to bless the people in the places you've sent me to?'

L: Listen. Don't talk, but listen to people - their struggles, their pains - in the places God sent you.

E: Eat. You can't just check this off. It's not quick. You have to have a meal with people or a cup of coffee. It builds relationships.

S: Serve. If you listen to people and you eat



with people, they will tell you how to love them and you'll know how to serve them.

S: Story. When the time is right, now we talk and we share the story of how Jesus changed our life.

People come to church, people become Christians, because of relationships. A couple months ago, my daughter asked me how adults become friends. I asked her how kids become friends, to which she responded, "You go up to someone and ask if you want to be friends." With adults it is a little more complicated; above all it takes time to build relationships. If we truly want to bless others, it will take building relationships with others.


Opening Doors Events

Do you remember your New Year's resolutions - to eat better and exercise more, perhaps? It is never to late to get back on track! Consider kick-starting again and try a 'Healthy Monday 'approach which might be:


