Then I told my grandfather about the shooting star. He explained to me that it meant someone had just died and gone to heaven. My eyes grew wide again as I asked "Really?"

Finally I told my older cousin, who happened to be a physics major. He began to explain to me about asteroids and large rocks that are remnants of the big bang and how,

when these rocks enter the earth's atmosphere, they begin to burn because of the friction generated.

Our scheduled rehearsal will take place starting Monday, Oct. 3rd, 7-9 p.m. at First


