Our focus through the month of May was on the great commission—our call to make disciples for Jesus Christ. This means both helping one another grow deeper in our faith, but especially helping folks find Jesus that have never known him before. The summer months in the life of our church will provide ample ministry opportunities to do this work, and we are excited to share them with you.

An ongoing outreach and discipleship event is our annual VBS. It will be hosted June 24-28 in the evenings, starting at 5pm with a community meal for children and their families. This is of course a great way to meet new folks in the community, but also to mingle with our sister church Shenango. We will be taking part in VBS together as we continue to discern our futures together as one church. Even if making a specific commitment to volunteer at VBS is too difficult for you, come and eat together with us and see what is happening. Remember, sometimes the Holy Spirit moves simply because we decide to show up!

A new outreach we are hosting is the Summer Food Program. This program seeks to feed children that are likely to receive free or reduced lunches during the school year, not knowing where nutrition may be found when they are not in school. We will be serving lunches every Monday through Thursday from noon to 1pm, starting June 10 and ending August 15 (except July 4). Like VBS, this is a great opportunity to meet new folks both inside and outside of the church while feeding the hungry. We will be partnering with Shenango Church in this endeavor as well as a few other area churches to help us accomplish this goal

We often pray in the Lord's Prayer "Thy kingdom come, thy will be done, **on earth as it is in heaven**". Likewise Jesus says in Matthew 19:14 "Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these.

While our hope for the future rests solely on the hope we have in Jesus Christ, children represent that future. Our prayer is that Clen-Moore would continue to invest in seeing the kingdom of heaven come to earth. Serving the children of our church and community are a great starting point!

As the skies turn blue and the summer sun begins to shine so, too, do we feel the warmth of our God as we are as busy as ever at Clen-Moore Church. We began June 2nd by celebrating with our church graduates during the morning worship. June 9th we welcomed our confirmation class into church membership. Assistance with the summer food program began June 10th with Clen-Moore being a host site.

Vacation Bible School is one of our biggest outreach opportunities with plans and preparations in full swing and ready for action June 24th through June 29th. And all the while, softball season is in full swing, as well as youth group, Prime Timers, choir, graduation parties and weddings all scheduled in our beautiful church. Unfortunately, building repairs and maintenance have been ongoing over the past few months and have eaten away the capital reserve account. The balance in that fund is currently a **negative \$50,000**. Costs for the new boiler, assembly room floors, outside doors, drinking fountains, and a new refrigerator have been necessary but also costly.


