As the summer comes to a close and we move into the fall months, the color of the leaves will not be the only thing changing! In September Aaron and Michael will begin a sermon series on worship. This series will help us understand what worship is, rather than what we often make it, exploring elements of worship, what it can look like to give God glory and praise, and more. After a lot of prayer and careful planning, we will be moving towards a "blended" service. It is neither contemporary or traditional; yet at the same time it is both. The choir, praise team, and special music will still be involved in the service, but will be utilized in different ways. More on that below.

Jane Karski will continue to serve as our organist/pianist, but with the resignation of Kathy Mansell as our Choir Director, there will also be changes to the music leadership. Pastor Michael will take over leadership of the praise team. Michalee Christy has agreed to serve as our Interim Choir director in addition to her work with the children's musical as we search for a new choir director. We will continue to utilize the many musical gifts of our congregation along the way for special music. This is where we are looking for help—we want you! If you have not been able to commit to one of the musical groups in the past, but desire to do so, talk to Aaron or Michael. Choir and praise team will be holding practices on Sunday mornings so it will be easier to participate. If you would prefer to offer special music as a vocal or instrumental solo, or small ensemble with others, let us know. Part of this change is intended to make musical participation more flexible for all involved.

You also may know by now that Shenango Church has officially voted to merge with Clen-Moore, which in many ways is exciting. It also comes with more questions. There are still many steps that need to take place before a true merger can be complete, but we intend to find ways to start living like one church in the meantime. Our short term solution is to hold a 9AM worship service at Shenango, and a 10:30AM service at Clen-Moore. Either Aaron or Michael will preach both services, so everyone will experience more or less the same worship any given week. If you like early worship, feel free to attend Shenango—we've encouraged them to do the same! If you do, please continue to designate your giving by marking your envelope. We hope this may create more opportunities to mingle together. We will also continue to plan occasional combined worship services. We will combine again at Clen-Moore Sunday, October 6th for World Communion Sunday.

Another way we will begin combining is getting folks of like mind and interests together. This part may be more of a work in progress as we go, but for example, we want to get people from both churches that are passionate about mission meeting and see how we can serve better TOGETHER. The same is true for all other aspects of church.
