5 Star Global Ministry has been one of our mission partners for several years now. Cofounded and led by New Wilmington native Autumn Marshall, 5 Star Global Ministry works primarily in northwest Haiti to empower families, caretakers, and locals to provide Christ-centered disability care and therapy, as well as training and educating nationals to provide disability advocacy.

Since our partnership with 5 Star Global Ministry began, Haiti has grown increasingly unstable. Famine and violence have left few there untouched, and 5 Star works with those who are most affected by these changes. Clen-Moore has helped to combat the rising food costs by supplying the 5 Star clinic with staple foods such as rice and beans, in addition to shipping backpacks and protein-heavy, shelf-stable foods for their annual Christmas party. Banditry and corruption have delayed some of these shipments, but most of the goods have finally arrived at the clinic and have been able to be dispersed to the families who attend. Autumn expects the remaining goods to arrive in the coming weeks as well (praise God!)

This month, Autumn has asked all of us to pray for the following items specifically:

- · Pray that Mission Aviation Fellowship (MAF) does not pull their planes out of Haiti, lest all Haitian missionaries be left stranded.
- · Pray for Autumn as she is dealing with some really tough staff issues and hard decisions that she is going to have to make. This is her hardest and most stressful return to Haiti yet.
- · Pray for all the kids (about ten in total) getting major orthopedic surgery this month and next. Pray for safe travels, safe surgeries, and quick, complete healing.
- · Pray for the clinic's outreach as they kick off a new year—that they would be able to love and serve each of their children and their families well.
