Dear Church Family,

Whether you refer to it as the word of God, scripture, or the Bible, we all know it as the core document of the Christian faith. Many of us have favorite verses and teachings, and probably know quite a few of the stories it contains. Yet I would also imagine that many people struggle to understand or dig into the entire book. I am even willing to admit that while I had read most of it, it was not until AFTER seminary that I set out to read the entire Bible cover to cover. It can be intimidating, confusing, and if you do not always follow what is happening it can even seem boring.

To help dive deeper into the book that we base our life of faith on, we are going to be doing an extensive church-wide teaching and preaching series called "The Story" by pastor and author Randy Frazee. It is scripture as we know it, formatted to read more like a novel, including some transitionary paragraphs that give commentary and help connect pieces together. You can buy it for less than \$10 online, though it is not necessary to purchase to take part. Each month in The Messenger, we will give the various scripture readings and chapters of the book that will be covered in Sunday school (for all ages) and sermons, as well as weekly listings in the worship bulletin for the upcoming Sunday.

This series is a whopping 31 chapters or sessions long, so it will conclude at the end of April 2024! As we go on this journey together, I am hoping for several things. One, I pray that it will give our entire church the chance to converse as we go from week to week. A second hope is that it will drive us to read our Bibles more regularly and confidently. From my own personal experience, there is no replacement for reading the Bible...no number of books on faith, inspiring sermons, or anything else will deepen an understanding of God the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit than digging into scripture for yourself.

One of our sister churches, Trinity Presbyterian Church, and Rev. Catherine Craley in Mercer will also be doing this series at the same time. The week prior to each chapter of the story, one or both of us will post an intro video or lesson preview to both of our churches.

As I think about the power of God's word in our lives, I am drawn to the first chapter of John's Gospel. John 1:14 says, "The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth." Though there are many things that may remain a mystery about God, the revealing of Jesus as the Word made flesh is not one of them. At times living out our Christian faith can be challenging and perplexing, but we make it more difficult when we spend little time with the greatest resource that tells the story—the word of God, scripture, or the Bible. As we embark on this journey, my prayer is that we would all grow in our faith through greater knowledge not only of scripture, but of Jesus himself, the revealed word of God to us all.


The Welcome Center
